WHEREAS: The Armed Forces of the United States, along with its NATO allies, participated in the Korean War during the years 1950-1953, and;

WHEREAS: 54,426 American military personnel were killed as a result of their participation in that war; and

WHEREAS: More than 700 young men from Minnesota were killed during the Korean war; and

WHEREAS: Congress has authorized the establishment of the Korean War Memorial, to be built in Washington, D.C.; and


WHEREAS: An international tribute to all veterans of the Korean War is scheduled to be held in Minnesota September 14-16, 1989; and

WHEREAS: It is truly appropriate to honor all those individuals who contributed so much towards the freedoms we all enjoy;
