WHEREAS: Leukemia and related diseases will strike 74,000 Americans this year and kill 43,700 of

our fellow citizens throughout the nation, many of them children; and

WHEREAS: The Leukemia Society of America is a national voluntary health agency dedicated to finding the causes of and cures for these life-threatening diseases through research;

and

WHEREAS: The annual Six Hours for Life Televent carries the Society's public health education message to patients and their families coast-to-coast and is a primary source of raising funds for research; and

WHEREAS: Recent new insights have caused the survival rate to double in the past twenty years, due in large measure to advances made by Leukemia Society sponsored scientists;

NOW, THEREFORE, 1, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, August 5, 1989 to be

LEUKEMIA SOCIETY DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEKEOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this twenty-seventh day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eignty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
