Mark Alan Jarboe was born in Flint, Michigan, on the nineteenth day of August, nineteen WHEREAS: hundred and fifty-one; and

WHEREAS: Mark Alan Jarboe graduated St. John Vianney High School, Flint, Michigan, 1968, in the top three percent; and

Mark Alan Jarboe matriculated at Northern Michigan University, 1968-1969, and at the University of Michigan, receiving his Bachelor of Arts Degree, with high distinction, 1972; and WHEREAS:
