WHEREAS: Good health is the more precious of a person's assets; and

WHEREAS: The medical record is a key to continuing health care; and

WHEREAS: The need for accurate and efficient medical records grows with the advent of more complex systems of health care and data related services; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Medical Record Association is composed of medical record administrators and medical record technicians employed in hospitals, extended care facilities, group practices, health centers, and other medical record and medical data related positions; and

WHEREAS: The standard of excellence of the work performed by members of the Minnesota Medical Record Association sets an example to which others should aspire; and

WHEREAS: The Medical Record professionals have a continuing goal, individually and collectively, to improve the quality and efficiency of medical record documentation and the protection of the patient's right to privacy;
