- WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Medical School celebrates its first hundred years with a fine record of achievement in research, education and service; and
- WHEREAS: Since its founding in 1888, the school has produced thousands of physicians and graduate students, many of whom have gone on to national and international prominence; and
- WHEREAS: Its faculty members have made basic biomedical and medical breakthroughs, saved countless lives, achieved numerous "firsts" and contributed to the advancement of medicine worldwide; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Medical Foundation was founded in 1939 by a dedicated group of faculty members and medical alumni who saw the need for private support to build a strong future for the Medical School; and
- WHEREAS: A non-profit organization, the Minnesota Medical Foundation raises and disburses funds for medical education and research at the University of Minnesota Medical Schools in the Twin Cities and Duluth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second day of June, 1989 to be
