



Proclamation

WHEREAS: 1989 marks the 60th anniversary of commercial air service into Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport; and

WHEREAS: Since its beginning, Minneapolis-St. Paul has developed into a major hub for commercial aviation activity, annually serving the needs of 17 million ticketed passengers and providing non-stop air service to hundreds of local, national and international destinations; and

WHEREAS: Minneapolis-St. Paul generates nearly 20,000 direct airport jobs and over 52,000 related or induced jobs, infusing billions of dollars into the state and local economy; and

WHEREAS: The Metropolitan Airports Commission and the Metropolitan Public Airport Foundation have organized one week of activities and public events around the theme "People, Planes and Progress" to celebrate this important public event;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 12-19, 1989 to be
