WHEREAS: Minnesota is recognized as the nation's leader in treating and responding to the problem of alcohol and other drug abuse; and

WHEREAS: Treatment professionals trained in Minnesota are sought and recruited for programs worldwide; and

WHEREAS: The most effective treatment for alcohol and other drug abuse is identified as the "Minnesota Model"; and

WHEREAS: Over 40,000 people are treated in Minnesota treatment programs each year; and

WHEREAS: 15% of those people are from other states, enriching the economy of the State of Minnesota by bringing in 15 million dollars each year; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota publicly supports a full continuum of alcohol and other drug abuse services, including treatment;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 21 to be

in Minnesota, and ask all Minnesotans to join me in congratulating the individuals who have made such treatment possible.


