WHEREAS: This mission can only be accomplished with the cooperation of public and private partners; and

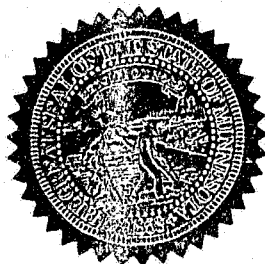
