



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: It is important that all of the citizens of Minnesota be aware of the importance of crime prevention programs and the valuable impact that their participation can have on reducing crime in our neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS: Community crime prevention programs play an important role in assisting Minnesota Police Departments through crime prevention efforts in our cities and towns; and
- WHEREAS: The National Association of Town Watch and the Minnesota Crime Prevention Officers Association is sponsoring a local effort of a special crime prevention project on August 8, 1989, called a "National Night Out";
- WHEREAS: The "National Night Out" provides an opportunity for the communities of Minnesota and other communities across the country to join together and demonstrate successful programs like crime watch; and
- WHEREAS: Neighborhood spirit and cooperation are the key ingredients of the "National Night Out" project and are helping Minnesota's Police Departments to fight crime;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, August 8, 1989, to be

NATIONAL NIGHT OUT DAY

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I call upon all citizens of Minnesota and upon all civic and educational organizations to join the National Association of Town Watch and the Minnesota Crime Prevention Officers Association in supporting and participating in "National Night Out" on August 8th.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
