- WHEREAS: The New Brighton Police Department has been accredited by the Commission on Accreditation For Law Enforcements Agencies, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS: It is the first police department in the State of Minnesota to become nationally accredited by this commission; and
- WHEREAS: The New Brighton Police Department has fully demonstrated its commitment to law enforcement, and to living up to a body of standards deemed necessary to protecting the life, health, safety and rights of the citizens it is serving; and
- WHEREAS: The New Brighton 20 member police force began this project in August, 1987; and
- WHEREAS: In order to become accredited, the police department had to carry out many required procedures and projects, including drafting a manual, standardizing all procedures, making regular checks of all equipment, and more; and
- WHEREAS: The New Brighton Police Department strives to serve the community of New Brighton in the best possible way;
