WHEREAS: His charitable endeavors, and his work with young people have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues, friends and family; and

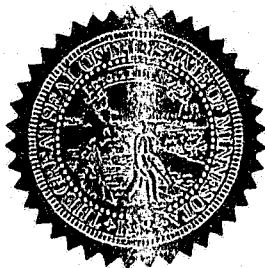
WHEREAS: He has consistently strived to keep the State Fair games honest and fair; and
