



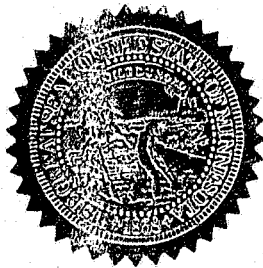
Proclamation
