- WHEREAS: Senior Olympics is a needed annual event which enables the senior participants to feel productive and worthwhile;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week of June to be

in Minnesota.


