

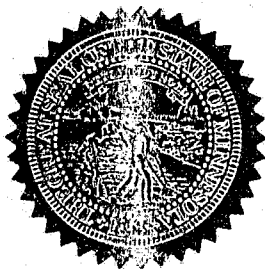


Proclamation
