- WHEREAS: Summer camps in Minnesota offer children individual and organized forms of recreation and the creative use of free time in an uncrowded wilderness environment; and
- WHEREAS: Summer camp opportunities throughout the State of Minnesota encompass a multitude of activities that can result in personal accomplishment, and self-satisfaction for all children; and
- WHEREAS: Children who attend summer camps in Minnesota have an opportunity to enjoy waterfront activities such as swimming, canoeing, boating and fishing, in an atmosphere that encourages safe water recreation and promotes water safety rules; and
- WHEREAS: Summer camps in Minnesota offer children positive leisure experiences which are vital to good physical and mental health and enhance the quality of life for all people; and
- WHEREAS: Summer camps in Minnesota offer our young people opportunities to develop important lifelong friendships through informal recreational and educational programs; and
- WHEREAS: Summer camp directors and camp staff members are to be commended for the work they do in offering young people in the State of Minnesota excellence in leadership, and for providing structure and guidance to campers which will add physical, social and spiritual dimensions to their lives;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 10-17, 1989 to be
