



Proclamation

WHEREAS: On July 6, 1989, we, the people of Minnesota will be one year away from the most spectacular multi-sport event ever to come to our area; and

WHEREAS: The day, July 6, 1989, shall kick off a year-long effort by Minnesotans to host 4,250 athletes, coaches and officials, who will participate in 38 sports, July 6-15, 1990; and

WHEREAS: The Twin Cities Festival Organizing Committee will involve 10,000 volunteers and attract 500,000 spectators for the 10-day event; and

WHEREAS: The unity of the public and private sector is accomplished through volunteerism, attendance and Minnesota corporate responsibility;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 6, 1989 to be

U.S. OLYMPIC FESTIVAL - '90 DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
