- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Health Care Engineers will be observing September 11-17, 1989 as Hospital Engineers Week;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 11th-17th, 1989 to be

in Minnesota in recognition of the vital contributions these health care professions make to the citizens of our state.


