

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF A VILLAGE.

To the honorable Board of County Commissioners of the County of ~~the~~
State of Minnesota:

We, the undersigned electors and residents residing upon the lands
or lots hereinafter described, respectfully show your honorable Board
represent and petition:

That the tracts of land, sections or parts of sections hereinafter
described are not within any incorporated village, and are
situated within the County of Chicago, State of Minnesota; that a
part of said hereinafter described tracts of land has been platted
into lots and blocks, and that the part of said tracts not platted
into lots and blocks are adjacent to the tracts so platted into lots
and blocks; that the plats of said platted portion of said tracts of
land have been duly and legally certified to according to the laws of
this state, and said plats duly filed in the office of the Register
of Deeds in and for said County of Chicago, said state; that said here-
inafter described tracts of land or territory contain a resident
population of not less than two hundred people and contain an actual
population at the date of this petition of 220 people;

That we hereby petition you to fix a time and place when and where
the electors actually residing upon said lands hereinafter described
may vote for or against the incorporation of said tracts of land into
a village as provided in and by Chapter 9 of the Revised Laws of the
State of Minnesota for the year 1805 and the laws amending and sup-
plemental thereto;

The tracts of land so sought to be incorporated into a village and
the boundaries of such territory, with the courses and distances are
as follows, viz:

commencing at the Northeast corner of Section One (1), Township Thirty-three (33) North, of Range Twenty-one (21) West; thence running south on the section line to the quarter section post in the East line of said section One (1); thence running west on the quarter section line to the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section One (1); thence running south on the one-sixteenth section lines of Sections One (1) and Twelve (12) in aforesaid town and range to the Northwest corner of Lot Three (3) of said Section Twelve (12); thence running east on the north line of said Lot Three (3) to the lake shore of Green Lake; thence running northeasterly along the lake shore of said Green Lake to the east line of Section One (1) aforesaid; thence running northeasterly and southeasterly along the lake shore of said Green Lake through Section Six (6), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20) to the south line of said Section Six (6); thence running southerly and southwesterly along the lake shore of said Green Lake through Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20) to the west line of said Section Seven (7); thence running westerly and easterly along the lake shore of Green Lake in Section Twelve (12), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty-one (21) to the east Section line of said Section Twelve (12); thence running easterly and southeasterly along the lake shore of Green Lake to the south line of Lot Four (4) in Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20); thence running east along the south line of Lots Four (4) and Five (5) of said Section Seven (7) to the east line of said Section Seven (7); thence running east on the south line of Lot Thirteen (13) of Chisago Villia according to the plot on file in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Chisago County to the shore line of Chisago Lake; thence running northwesterly along the lake shore of said Chisago Lake to the north line of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20); thence running northerly and northeasterly along the lake shore of said Chisago Lake to the east line of Section Six (6), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20); thence northeasterly along the lake shore of said Chisago Lake to the North line of Section Five (5) of last named town and range; thence running west

on the north line of Sections Five (5) and Six (6) of last named town and range to the place of commencement.

That said hereinbefore described territory and said tracts of land proposed and sought to be incorporated as a village are described in and by the United States Government survey as:-

The North half of the Northeast quarter (N 1/2 of NE 1/4), Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter (SW 1/4 of NE 1/4), East half of Northwest quarter (E1/2 of NW 1/4), East half of Southwest quarter (E1/2 of SW 1/4), Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter (SW 1/4 of SE 1/4), Lots Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5) in Section One (1); the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE 1/4 of NW 1/4), Lots One (1) and Two (2) Section Twelve (12) in Township Thirty-three (33) North, of Range Twenty-one (21) West;

The Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4 of NW 1/4), Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Section Five (5); all of Section Six (6); Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5) in Section Seven (7) and so much of Lot Six (6) in Section Eight (8), Township Thirty-three (33), Range Twenty (20) as is platted into Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12) and Thirteen (13) of Chisago Villas according to plat on file in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Chisago County, all in Township Thirty-three (33) North, of Range Twenty (20) West;

That the quantity of land embraced therein is twelve hundred and three (1203) acres, more or less, according to the Government survey thereof;

That the name proposed for said Village so sought to be incorporated is the Village of Chisago City.

That the number of persons actually residing within said hereinbefore described territory is 320 people which fact has been duly ascertained under the directions of the undersigned petitioners by a census census duly taken of the resident population on the 1st, day of June 1906.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that your honorable board will post or cause to be posted in three public places within said territory

copies of this petition and the verification thereof together with a notice attached thereto, stating the time and place within the limits of said proposed village, when and where the electors thereof will vote for or against the incorporation of said territory as a village.

Also, the undersigned electors and residents residing upon the land
or lots hereinbelow described, respectfully show your honorable Board,
resolutions and petition:

That the tracts of land, sections or parts of sections hereinbelow
described are not within any incorporated village, and are
situated within the County of Clatsop, State of Oregon; that a
part of said hereinbelow described tract of land has been platted
into lots and blocks, and that the part of said tract not platted
into lots and blocks are adjacent to the tracts so platted into lots
and blocks; that the parts of said platted portion of said tract of
land have been duly and legally certified to according to the laws of
this state, and said plat duly filed in the office of the Register
of Deeds in and for the County of Clatsop, said state; that said here-
inbefore described tracts of land or territory contain a resident
population of not less than one hundred people and contain an actual
population at the date of this petition of 800 people;

That we hereby petition you to fix a time and place wherein
the officers actually residing upon said lands hereinabove described
may meet you to examine the incorporation of said tracts of land into
a village as provided in and by Chapter 2 of the Revised Laws of the
State of Oregon for the year 1878 and the like statutory and
municipal laws;

The tracts of land so named to be incorporated into a village in
