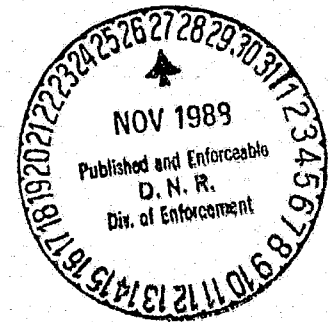

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER NO. 2360



REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE MANAGEMENT
OF CERTAIN LAKES AS EXPERIMENTAL WATERS
TO FURTHER EXPERIMENTS AND RESEARCH

Pursuant to authority vested in me by Minn. Stat.
§ 97C.001 and other applicable law, I, Joseph N. Alexander,
Commissioner of Natural Resources, hereby prescribe the following
regulations relating to certain lakes to further experiments and
research.

Section 1. Restrictions on Big Sand Lake, T. 141,
R. 34, S. 22, 23, 26, 27, 33, 35, Hubbard County: While on or
fishing in the waters of Big Sand Lake, the limit for northern
pike is three (3) with no more than one (1) northern pike in
possession with a length of more than 24 inches. The limit of
walleye is six (6) with no more than one (1) walleye in
possession over 20 inches. The length shall be measured from the
tip of the nose to the tip of the tail when fully extended.

Sec. 2. All northern pike and walleye in possession
while on the waters of Big Sand Lake, regardless of where taken,
must be intact and measurable. Northern pike and walleye fillets
shall not be possessed while on the above waters.


Sec. 3. The spearing ban in accordance with
Commissioner's Order No. 2346 or its successors also applies to
Big Sand Lake.




