WHEREAS: Ames School, 1760 Ames Place, St. Paul, Minnesota, first admitted students on the East Side of St. Paul, on November 4, 1889; and

WHEREAS: There was a large population growth on the East Side; a new school was built in 1916, and added onto in 1956; and

WHEREAS: Ames School has developed pride and excellence in education and in the East Side through its many notable staff members and graduates; and

WHEREAS: Ames School has served the community for 100 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the school year, 1989-90, to be

AMES CENTENNIAL YEAR

in Minnesota, in honor of the 100th anniversary of its origin.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
