WHEREAS: Children are Minnesota's greatest natural resource; and

WHEREAS: In many areas of Minnesota, youth are helping each other and their community through youth service programs and deserve recognition for their commitment; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans have a long history of national leadership in meeting the needs of children; and

WHEREAS: All Minnesotans need to become aware of all that has been done, and all that remains to be done to meet the needs of our children; and

WHEREAS: Each of us needs to be involved in a positive way with all the children we meet;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 8, 1989 to be

CHILDREN'S DAY

and October 8-14, 1989 to be

CHILDREN'S WEEK

in Minnesota, and encourage all Minnesota citizens to resolve to become involved and to make children our number one priority.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
