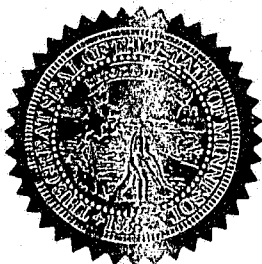
WHEREAS: Claudia Hampston Daly has helped launch the careers of many journalists and music announcers and is a role model for women in the broadcast industry regionally and nationally;
