WHEREAS: The St. Francis City Council and the St. Francis Police Department are holding the First Annual Community Awareness Resource Expo (C.A.R.E) day at the St. Francis Mall on September 30, 1989; and

WHEREAS: This event will include a wide array of public safety displays, including an air ambulance helicopter, the State Patrol Search and Rescue Helicopter, a fire department demonstration of the "Hurst" Rescue & Extraction Tool, a K-9 demonstration, and approximately twenty informational booths relating to public safety; and
