WHEREAS: The Employee Recognition Day will feature an awards program relating to the Department's mission statement, with recognition given to outstanding individuals and teams;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 20, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


