WHEREAS: There are 375,000 children of pre-school age in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: These children are Minnesota's most valuable asset and resource; and

WHEREAS: No occupation is more important than that of child rearing; and

WHEREAS: Many families in Minnesota are forced to seek child care outside their own homes; and

WHEREAS: The licensed family child caregivers of Minnesota are professional people devoted to

achieving and maintaining the highest level of parenting skills; and

WHEREAS: The licensed family child caregivers are highly competent, dedicated, caring, concerned

individuals;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the last week of March, 1990 to be

FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDER WEEK

in Minnesota.
