WHEREAS: The work in Fiber Arts in the region is a high quality, creative part of the arts community; and

WHEREAS: The Fiber Arts being produced in the region include weaving, surface design, quilting, embroidery, basketry, handmade paper, and leather; and

WHEREAS: FIBERS MINNESOTA is a juried show and sale organized by The Minnesota Crafts Council, Weavers Guild of Minnesota, Minnesota Lace Society, Surface Design Minnesota, American Sewing Guild, and Minnesota Valley Fiber Guild, as a showcase for the high quality work being produced in Fiber Arts; and

WHEREAS: FIBERS MINNESOTA will take place at Calhoun Square in Uptown Minneapolis on October 21 and 22, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the third week of October to be
