WHEREAS: Schools provide the foundation for the development of our nation's young people into knowledgeable, responsible and productive citizens; and

WHEREAS: Safe schools are necessary for productive learning; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's children are entitled to a safe, secure and peaceful environment that fosters their education and health; and

WHEREAS: Our children must have schools free of drugs, drug trafficking, gangs, weapons, vandalism and bullying; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has established Drug Free School and Park zones to send the message that drug trafficking will not be tolerated near our children; and

WHEREAS: The week of October 15-21, 1989, has been designated America's Safe Schools Week on the national level;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 15-21, 1989 to be

MINNESOTA'S SAFE SCHOOLS WEEK

in Minnesota.
