WHEREAS: Fires in the home continue to be a major threat to all Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: During 1989 fires have taken more than 50 lives and injured hundreds of others across

the state; and

WHEREAS: The safety of Minnesotans in their homes should be a concern for all citizens; and

WHEREAS: Smoke detectors have proved to be the most effective life-saving device during fires;

and

WHEREAS: The practice of home fire drills, in conjunction with properly working smoke detectors,

will definitely save many Minnesotans involved in fires each year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 28, 1989 to be

MINNESOTA STATEWIDE FIRE DRILL PRACTICE DAY

in Minnesota, and encourage all Minnesotans to establish a fire drill for their homes.
