WHEREAS: The students in the Owatonna High School Marching Band deserve to be commended for their dedication and commitment to the band;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 26, 1989 to be

In Minnesota.


