



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The production and distribution of food is society's most basic and essential service;
and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is fortunate to have an abundant and diversified agricultural system with farmers who are leading producers of commodities such as corn, soybeans, wheat and sugar beets along with dairy, livestock and poultry products; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's complex food and fiber system also includes quality transportation systems, communication networks, input suppliers, handling facilities, marketing systems and trade and export companies; and

WHEREAS: October 16th of each year is traditionally designated as a time to focus public attention on issues confronting food policy in order to provide for the world's needy a more healthy and abundant food supply;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 16, 1989 to be

WORLD FOOD DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eleventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
