



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Midwest Section of the Society for Accelerative Learning and Teaching (SALT) will hold its annual conference November 2-4 at Minneapolis Community College. It is being sponsored by the Minnesota State University System, Metropolitan State University, Winona State University, Minneapolis Community College, Southwest State University, and the State Board of Vocational Technical Education; and

WHEREAS: Accelerative teachers create a positive supporting psychological environment for the student and his or her abilities, thereby increasing students' feeling of self worth and reducing discipline problems; and

WHEREAS: Accelerative teaching involves communicating with the student through visual, auditorial, kinesthetic and other modes, so a large proportion of students' individual learning styles are matched; and

WHEREAS: Accelerative teaching methods are effective with students at every level of ability; and

WHEREAS: Accelerative teachers recognize that learning should be, and can be, fun, rather than work, and when learning is so presented, nearly all students learn rapidly and easily; and

WHEREAS: Learning by accelerative methods has been shown to be twice or more as effective as by conventional methods;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 29 - November 4, 1989 to be
