WHEREAS: In Minnesota every year the number of crimes against children increases, including physical abuse, kidnapping, sexual assault, and murder; and

WHEREAS: The impact of these attacks on children can be emotionally devastating, not only for the children, but for their families; and

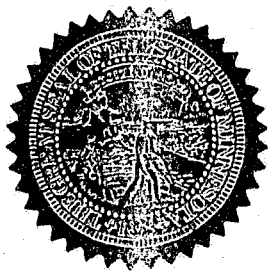
WHEREAS: There is a great need to increase public awareness about the issue of self-protection for children in order to keep children safer, and to prevent future attacks and assaults; and
