- WHEREAS: The computer/data processing industry is deeply involved in furthering the development of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Computer/data processing companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for the State of Minnesota and its citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Computer/data processing education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Three professional organizations, the Data Processing Management Association, Association of Computing Machinery and Association of Systems Management, promote the interests of the industry and the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the computer/data processing industry will be achieved by the upcoming 27th annual Northwest Computer Show and the 12th annual Minnesota Joint Computer Conference; and
- WHEREAS: These two events held jointly will bring together a few thousand Minnesota companies, about 150 exhibits and over 6,000 professional data processing and corporate management personnel;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fourth week of February to be
