WHEREAS: The evening will include dinner, cocktails, and dancing, with music by the Celebrity Strings Orchestra; and

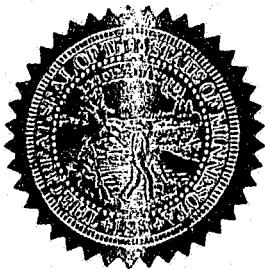
