



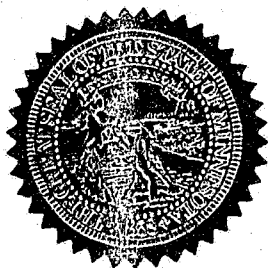
Proclamation

- WHEREAS:** Acid rain, depletion of the ozone layer, persistent toxic chemicals, and global warming present new and significant threats to the earth's atmosphere; and
- WHEREAS:** These air pollution problems are created by humankind's activities throughout the globe; and
- WHEREAS:** Air pollution does not respect international boundaries; and
- WHEREAS:** The solutions to these threats to the earth's atmosphere must be international in nature; and
- WHEREAS:** The shared spirit of cooperation, dedication and commitment to the resolution of these problems is evidenced by the gathering of officials from many different countries to study air pollution issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 5-13, 1989 to be
