



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Mid-America Aviation Resource Consortium (MARC) is a cooperative effort of the Minnesota Department of Transportation Office of Aeronautics, the Minnesota Education Systems, the Minnesota Aviation Community, and the Federal Aviation Administration, and is supported by the aviation industry; and

WHEREAS: MARC's purpose is to coordinate aviation education and training for government and the aviation industry in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Federal Aviation Administration has chosen MARC to develop a model program for training air-traffic controllers; and

WHEREAS: The Air Traffic Control training is proposed as a nine month curriculum to supplement degree programs from colleges and universities in the state and region; and

WHEREAS: On Monday, December 11, 1989 the MARC Air Traffic Control Training Center at the Flying Cloud Airport will be dedicated;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, December 11, 1989 to be
