WHEREAS: Mary Hart Sorensen joined the staff of the Minneapolis Tribune in June 1945; and

WHEREAS: She has been providing Minnesotans with good recipes and helpful homemaking information

ever since; and

WHEREAS: For many of those years she has written a column called "Ask Mary;" and

WHEREAS: Thousands of Minnesotans have asked Mary, and for millions her name has become

synonymous with tasty food and good advice; and

WHEREAS: She has prepared more versions of hamburger hot dish than any human being should have

been required to do; and

WHEREAS: She is retiring from the newspaper after 44 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 30th day of November, 1989 to be

MARY HART DAY

in Minnesota.
