WHEREAS: During 1989 the Minnesota Meals on Wheels programs throughout the state served 1,307,327 meals to 14,648 Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: The dedication of 380 providers of service, and the donation of 100,000 volunteer hours to deliver the meals made this project possible; and

WHEREAS: The dedication of these volunteers in helping people receive hot, nutritious meals each day ensures the continued well-being of many persons; and

WHEREAS: Nutritious food is an essential ingredient to the maintenance of life; and
