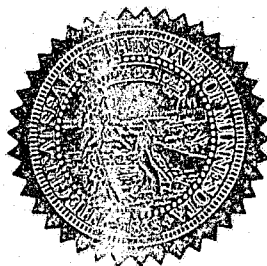
WHEREAS: The Minnesota Profession Fire Fighters have designated fundraising for MDA as a priority project; and
