WHEREAS: On November 17, an anniversary celebration will be held at the Holiday Inn Metrodome, Minneapolis to commemorate this important milestone in our history;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 17, 1989 to be
