WHEREAS: The healthcare community now recognizes the Medical Staff Services Professional as the key administrative person in the support of medical staff services; and

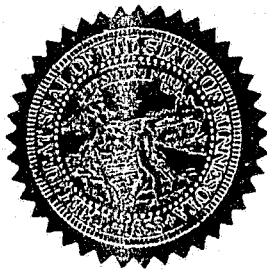
WHEREAS: The National Association Medical Staff Services will continue to provide its membership with opportunities for continuing education and provisions for networking;
