WHEREAS: Eyecare and eyewear professionals and manufacturers have made services and products available to help all who need vision enhancement, augmentation and protection; and

WHEREAS: The opticians of the State of Minnesota are qualified through training, experience, continuing education, and voluntary certification to assure proper filling of the eye doctor's prescription; and

WHEREAS: Opticians provide freedom of choice to eyewear consumers and are the competitive balance that keeps eyewear within the means of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS: The month of January 1990 is being observed as National Opticians Month under the auspices of the Opticians Association of America and the Minnesota Opticians Society to acknowledge the role of dispensing opticians in assuring the best possible eyesight for all;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January, 1990 to be
