

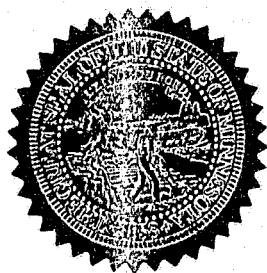


## Proclamation
