WHEREAS: Robert M. Anderson is retiring as superintendent of the Education Building of the Minnesota State Fair; and

WHEREAS: The Education Building has been the focal point for millions of Minnesota residents to be informed of educational programs and services to improve the health, education and welfare of Minnesota citizens; and

WHEREAS: Robert M. Anderson was instrumental in expanding vocational education to thousands of Minnesotans in northern Minnesota through coordination of the Upper Great Lakes Commission funds for education; and

WHEREAS: Robert M. Anderson, of the Minnesota State Board of Vocational Technical Education, established the Minnesota Vocational Technical Trust Association to provide for private industry to donate millions of dollars of products and equipment to Minnesota's secondary and post-secondary institutions for improved education;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 3, 1989 to be
