



## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Rolf Olson is a native Minnesotan, a graduate of Roosevelt High School in Minneapolis, and has lived all of his life in Minnesota, serving on numerous community action groups; and
- WHEREAS: Rolf Olson enlisted in the United States Army in World War II, and served in France as a combat infantryman; and
- WHEREAS: After serving over three months in intensive combat, Rolf was seriously injured by an exploding shell, which essentially destroyed his left knee; and
- WHEREAS: After discharge, Rolf became a member of the Disabled American Veterans, and has served honorably in many different positions for them; and
- WHEREAS: He also has served other veterans organizations admirably in posts of Commander, Senior Vice Commander, and as a member of over twelve committees, both in support of veterans' causes, and in helping his fellow man; and
- WHEREAS: Rolf Olson has served his family, his nation, and his community admirably over all the years of his life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, November 12, 1989 to be
