WHEREAS: On Wednesday, November 29, the Print Communications Division is dedicating one of its printing presses to 100% usage of soybean-based ink; and

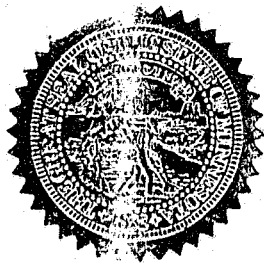
WHEREAS: This dedication reflects the State of Minnesota's commitment to soybean products;
