WHEREAS: Steve Apfelbacher, a graduate of South St. Paul High School and the University of Minnesota, was elected to the South St. Paul City Council in 1971, as the youngest councilman elected in the city of St. Paul; and

WHEREAS: In 1985, Steve was one of four partners to purchase Ehlers and Associates, and he became President of the company in 1988; and

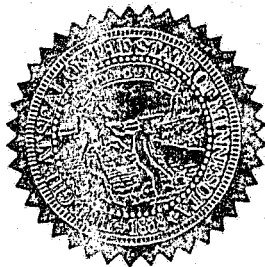
WHEREAS: Steve and his wife Nancy live in South St. Paul with their two sons, Kurt and Mark; and
