WHEREAS: Minnesota 4-H Youth Development has identified career development education as one of the four priority issues for the 1990's; and

WHEREAS: Rural youth in particular have been found to have limited access to career planning information; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota 4-H, with major support from the The Pillsbury Company Foundation, has developed a career planning curriculum designed to meet the needs of Minnesota's rural youth; and

WHEREAS: This curriculum encourages these youth to "Take Charge" of their futures by doing life planning; and

WHEREAS: This curriculum is now available to all Minnesota young people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.
