WHEREAS: The citizens of Carlton County recognize the important role of volunteers and use them as a resource throughout public and private organizations; and

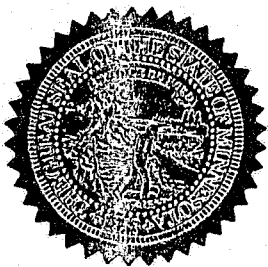
WHEREAS: Leaders from Carlton County communities are working in partnership through Leadership Carlton County to develop volunteer networks and empower volunteers to create change; and
