WHEREAS: Minnesota has some of the best cross-country skiing in the world; and

WHEREAS: Cross-country skiers enjoy the benefits of physical fitness that come with the practice of the sport; and

WHEREAS: This family activity brings thousands of people into the great Minnesota outdoors annually; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Office of Tourism, the Department of Natural Resources, and the State and County parks are leaders in promoting cross-country skiing;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 13, 1990 to be

in Minnesota, and I urge all Minnesotans to experience the Minnesota landscapes of winter by taking the opportunity to participate in cross-country skiing.
